## **Civil Service Jobs in New York State**

Civil Service jobs in New York State can be offered either by local jurisdictions or by the state itself. There are several web sites you can use to locate possible jobs and find more information about them.

Start with the <u>New York State Department of Civil Service</u> and click "Learn More" under "Job Seekers" to access the state and local employment opportunities information:





Then you can investigate job openings with the state government and job openings with various local agencies:


